STANDING ORDER

Currently, there is a lapse of federal appropriations funding the operations of the U.S. Marshals Service. Regardless of that lapse in appropriations, the work of the U.S. Marshals Service is necessary to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina's continued performance of its constitutional duty to hear and decide cases without interruption. Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the U.S. Marshals Service shall continue to effect civil process as ordered by the Court; provide any and all services as directed by the Court in both civil and criminal actions; maintain all functions necessary for the appropriate security of all judges and court employees; and provide for the safe use of all court facilities in the Eastern District of North Carolina.
