


Pursuant to the authority of Section 2241(d) of  
Title 28 of the United States Code (Public Laws 89-590),  
and for good cause appearing therefor, and in furtherance  
of justice and in the exercise of the court's discretion,

It is hereby ORDERED that an application for a  
writ of habeas corpus made by a person in custody under the  
judgment and sentence of a court of the State of North Caro-  
lina shall be filed, heard, and determined in the district  
court for the district within which the state court was  
held which convicted and sentenced him, and the clerks of  
the several district courts are authorized and directed to  
transfer such applications to the district herein designated  
for filing, hearing, and determination.

An original of this Order shall be filed and entered  
on the records of the district courts in Raleigh, Greensboro,  
and Asheville, North Carolina, and a copy of said Order filed  
in each of the divisions of said court in which records are  
kept.
