

New Fees and Fee Increases Effective December 1, 2013

At its September 2013 session, the Judicial Conference of the United States approved changes to the federal court miscellaneous fee schedules. The following changes take effect on December 1, 2013:

1. The filing or “docketing” fee for an appeal to a United States Court of Appeals will increase to a total of \$500.
2. The fee for retrieval of box records from the National Archives and Records Administration will increase to \$64 for the first box. A new fee of \$39 for each additional box requested was created.
3. A new fee of \$176 has been set for the filing of a motion for sale of property free and clear of liens under 11 U.S.C. § 363(f) in a bankruptcy case.
4. The \$53 fee for checks returned for insufficient funds on each of the court fee schedules applies to checks, electronic payments, or any form of payment returned or denied for insufficient funds.
