

STANDING ORDER AUTHORIZING REVENUE OFFICERS  
TO MAKE PERSONAL SERVICE OF PROCESS IN  
TAX SUMMONS ENFORCEMENT CASES


The United States Attorney has applied to the court for an order authorizing revenue officers in the collection division to make personal service of the court's process in proceedings initiated by the United States to enforce tax summonses. The United States Attorney having demonstrated good cause for issuance of the order, and it appearing that the court has authority pursuant to Rule 4(c)(B) to appoint a special process server to serve process on behalf of the United States, it is hereby ordered that revenue officers in the collection division of the Internal Revenue Service are authorized to make service of process in the aforementioned cases.
