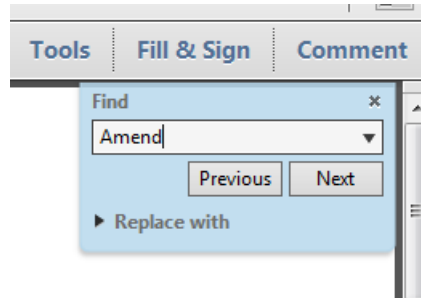


How to Make A PDF Text Searchable

To determine if your PDF is Text Searchable: Hit Ctrl + F and search for a word that is contained in the document.

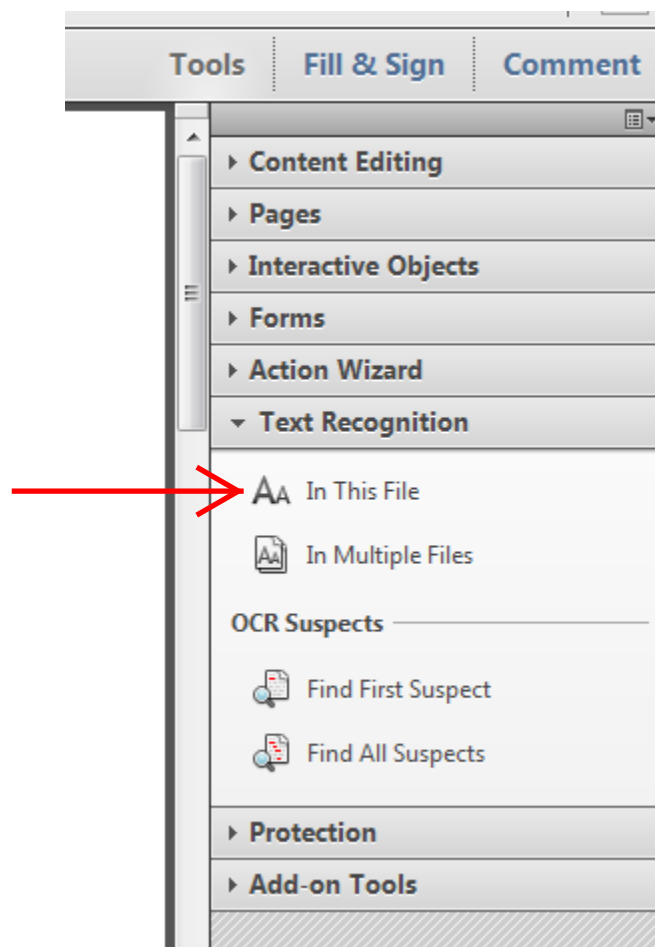

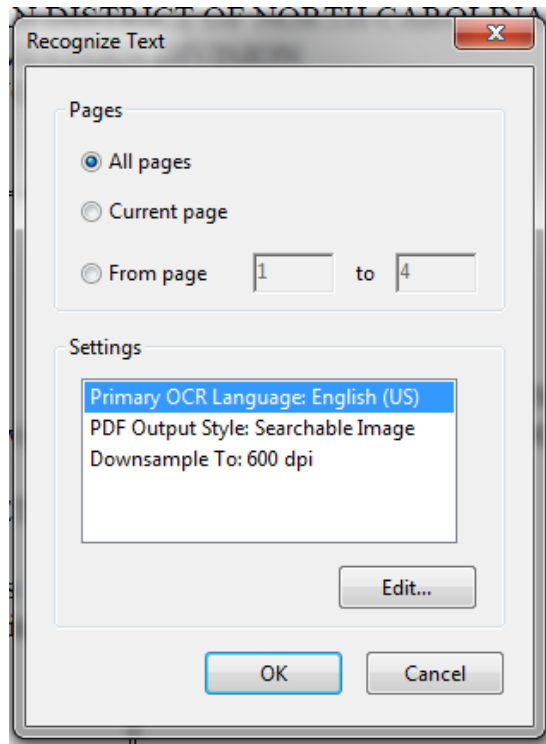
If the document is text searchable it will find the word in the document.

To Make An Existing PDF Text Searchable:

- 1) Under **Tools** → **Text Recognition** select **In This File**



2) Select **Primary OCR Language: English (US)** under Settings and hit **OK**.



The PDF should now be text searchable.

To Adjust the Settings on your Scanner to Automatically Create Text Searchable PDFs:

In Adobe, select **Create → PDF from scanner** and then **configure presets**. Make sure the **Make Searchable (Run OCR)** is selected.
