ORDER DESIGNATION LOCATION OF MARSHAL'S SALES. DIST. NO. CAR.

For purposes of all sales conducted by the United States Marshal, the notice of sale shall clearly specify the date, time and location of the sale. If the notice of sale specifies that the sale shall be conducted at a place of holding court within this District, the location of the sale shall be as follows:

(1) ELIZABETH CITY:

In the Main Street lobby of the U.S. Courthouse & Federal Building, 206 E. Main Street, Elizabeth City, N.C.

(2) FAYETTEVILLE:

In the Green Street lobby of the U.S. Post Office and Courthouse, 301 Green Street, Fayetteville, N.C.

(3) NEW BERN:

In the Middle Street lobby of the U. S. Post Office and Courthouse, Middle Street, New Bern, N.C.

(4) RALEIGH:

In the New Bern Avenue lobby U. S. Post Office and Courthouse, 310 New Bern Avenue, Raleigh, N.C.

(5) WILMINGTON:

In the Princess Street lobby of the Federal Building, Wilmington, N.C.

(6) WILSON:

In the Nash Street lobby of the U. S. Post Office and Courthouse, 224 E. Nash Street, Wilson, N.C.

For all sales conducted at a county courthouse, the sale shall be conducted at the place such sales are usually held. This rule does not limit the right of the Marshal to conduct sales where the property is seized or stored.
